WASHINGTON.

The Attorney General has instructed United States District Attorney Beckwith to make a thorough investigation of the affair in Grant parish, and if the United States laws have been violated to spare no pains or expense in causing the guilty parties to be arrested, if necessary, to execute any United States process, to call upon General Emory for that purpose, as he (General Emory) has been instructed by the Acting Secretary of War to give him all aid.
