Rev. Father Grigard, a Catholic priest, arrived here yesterday from Monroe, to fill the place vacant by the death of Father Pierre.

The epidemic exhibits no abatement. Although the patients are not so numerous owing to the limited material to work on, we continually hear of them, and in the absence of any organization to make a report, we are unable to state the exact number of those who are still suffering.
