

the cities of Alexandria, Natchitoches and Greenvort and town of Vermilionville, from the construction of the main line of railroad from New Orleans to Greenvort, La. It shall be lawful for said hereinbefore named, or either of all of them, to issue bonds to aid in the construction of said line of road, and to mortgage such bonds to the company for such purposes to such amount, payable at such time or times, and in such form and with such conditions, and to deliver the same to said company at such times as may be agreed upon by the directors of said company and the police jury of the parish, or the mayor and council of the city, to issue the bonds, provided that before such bonds shall be issued, the police jury of said parish, or the mayor and council of such city, shall cause to be published in a newspaper published in such parish or city for three months, a copy of the ordinance to be adopted by the voters cast shall be in favor of such agreement, the bonds of the parish or city may then be issued, and the same shall be sold, or otherwise provided further, that the police jury of any of the above named parishes shall be required, on the written application of any duly qualified elector, to submit such ordinance to the voters of such parish, and in any of the cities or towns above mentioned the mayor and town council, on the written application of any duly qualified elector, shall submit the agreement to the voters of said city or town; and all bonds issued in accordance with the provisions of this section shall be valid and binding obligations of the parish or city issuing such bonds, and a special tax shall be therefor levied and collected, as other taxes are levied and collected, on the property of such parish or city, for the payment of the interest and principal of the bonds, according to the terms of the bonds and of the agreement under which they were issued, and all the terms and conditions of any agreement made and approved as hereinbefore named shall be and remain in full force and effect, and the interest and principal of bonds issued by virtue of such agreement have been fully paid.

Sec. 21. Be it further enacted, etc., That nothing in this act contained shall be construed as interfering with or diverting the New Orleans, Mobile and Texas Railroad Company of any of its rights or privileges in carrying out and maintaining its line of road, or giving up or abandoning any right which the State of Louisiana may now have to stock or any other interest of or in the said New Orleans, Mobile and Texas Railroad Company. And this law shall not take effect or be of any force unless the said New Orleans, Mobile and Texas Railroad Company and the State of Louisiana shall, through their respective boards of directors, file in the office of the Secretary of State, within ninety days from after the date of the passage and approval of this act, a copy of the agreement, signed by a majority of the directors of said company, and when so deposited, the rights and franchises granted by this act shall be valid and binding contracts to be and shall be binding contracts between the State of Louisiana and the said new company, and shall not be impaired, diminished or in any way affected, except with the consent and on the petition of said company.

Sec. 22. Be it further enacted, etc., That no distribution or distribution shall be made of the stock of said New Orleans, Mobile and Texas Railroad Company, on account of race, or color, or previous condition, between the persons employed in the construction and maintenance of the line of road, or in any way, either in their railway carriages, in their depot buildings, or upon their boats within this State. That in any violation of the provisions of this act, any person shall be liable to a fine of not more than one thousand dollars, to be recovered out of any funds of said company, before any court of competent jurisdiction; or he may be imprisoned for any term not exceeding ninety days, or both, at the discretion of the court.

Sec. 23. Be it further enacted, etc., That if any of the foregoing sections of this act, or any of its provisions, or any part thereof, shall be in violation of any contract between the State of Louisiana and any railroad or railway company, then such section or provision of law shall be null and void, and the provisions of the act be and they are hereby repealed.
