THE GRANT PARISH PRISONERS.

They are in the United States Circuit Court.

Judges Bradley and Woods sat in the United States Circuit Court yesterday to try the Grant parish prisoners, J. W. Cruikshank and others, charged with conspiracy and murder in Colfax, Grant parish, in the month of April, 1873.

This is the second trial on the same charge, at the first trial the jury failing to agree on a verdict.

Mr. Whitaker, for the defense, read a challenge to the entire jury, giving several reasons. First, because the jury was not drawn as near as practicable to the laws of Louisiana. Because the drawing had been made in a large majority. Also because of some irregularity not specifically stated.

One reason after another was spoiled, and finally the court decided that the challenge did not possess sufficient weight to interrupt proceedings.

Jurymen and witnesses were called, nearly all of them responding.

United States District Attorney Book with seemed inclined to waste but little time in questioning those who were called to the jury box, but the defense very searching in their interrogations, challenging nearly all.

In one instance a man was asked a question and he answered that he was a policeman. Defense informed him that he was exempt from jury duty by law, and indirectly endeavored to induce him to waive himself of said provision, but Mr. Juryman would not see it. Judge Bradley read the section, and declared that although a man is exempt by the clause, it does not debar him from sitting if he chooses to—the exemption does not prevent any person acting as a jurymen.

This questioning consumed much time, and it was nearly two o'clock when called jurors were secured. Their names are as follows, all white:

John Mulvey, Alexander McKee, Thomas Keady, Joseph Doughton, J. C. Gannon, George D. Wright, Charles Barnard, Florville Foy.

The court will sit at ten o'clock this morning and probably complete the jury.

Mr. Book with was packed with people, all of whom appeared greatly interested in the proceedings.

Prosecution and defense have long lists of witnesses, and Mr. Book with estimated that the case could last at least two weeks.

Death of General Hartuff.

All whose fortune it was to know Major General George L. Hartuff, of the United States army, are pained to learn of his death, which occurred at the Sturtevant House, New York, last Friday night.

General Hartuff was a graduate of the Military Academy at West Point, and entered service as lieutenant of artillery in 1852. He was made brigadier and afterwards major-general of volunteers in 1862, and was actively engaged during the rebellion, as brigade, division and corps commander. After the war he came to this department as lieutenant colonel and assistant adjutant general, assigned to duty on the staff of General Sheridan. He also remained for a time in that capacity during the command of General Hancock here. Of the old school, he was a courteous gentleman and a noble soldier.

The record of his military life is an enviable one. He retired from active service, June 29, 1871, with the highest rank held by him in the volunteer service. Subsequently, he went to Europe, partially to benefit his health, and also as agent for the American Gatling gun manufacturers. General Hartuff's death was caused by pneumonia, and was so unexpected that but a few days before he was announced to preside over one of the corps meetings at the present at Harris
