REMINISCENCES OF MEXICO

The veterans of the Mexican war residing in Indiana met in Indianapolis, on Wednesday last, and organized a State association. Speeches were made by Generals Lane, Manson and Chapman, and Colonel Osborne, and the following letter from General Lew Wallace was read:

It is a matter of great regret to me that I can not be present at this meeting to-morrow. No one esteems comradeship more highly than I do, to no one are its memories more delightful; more than anything else—more than the life itself—more than the hopes and expectations of the future, they serve to while away my hours of rest and reverie, and for that alone would not part with my experience as a soldier for any consideration. Since the campaigns of 1847-53, which you are preparing to commemorate, many of us have trodden a much broader field of war with appointments and more grand, yet I venture to assert that there is not one of us to whom the service in Mexico is not a recollection passing in interest the most brilliant and successful of our life.
