consistency of France toward Spain more manifest.

M. Bouillier de Broche, of the extreme right, uttered a protest against the recall to the Ormeque as a proceeding unworthy of the dignity as well as the interests of France.

The Duke Decazes replied that the Pope had neither complained nor in any way blamed the French government.

Chabrol de Lionnois, member of the Interior, in reply to the question, stated the government held itself neutral in the elections in Nice.

M. Picquet gave notice the Republicans, at the meeting of the Assembly, would introduce an interpellation, with the view of taking the judgment of the House on the systematic violation by the government of the liberties of the electors and of the press.

George Perin, radical deputy of the Assembly, fought a duel to-day with the editor of the Bonapartist journal, which were slightly wounded.

The Italian government is now aware of the violent attacks made by a Frenchman on the MacMahon government, and has notified the French government that it will not tolerate the violation of the neutrality of the Italian territory.

Paris, October 16.—The report that there has been captured by Italian brigands is described. The brigands did not get away with anything.

Florence, October 16.—There is no truth in the report that the Italian government has requested Thiers to quit Italy.

Madrid, October 16.—Don Carlos is at Tolosa. There are reports about the defeat of Carlisle bands, and their efforts to surrender.

Berlin, October 16.—Von Arnim's residence in this city was again searched to-day by the police and agents of the government.

The South American Troubles. Rio Janeiro, October 15.—Dispatches from Buenos Ayres of yesterday's date have been received.

A new cabinet has been formed, with Alphonse de Broche, Minister of Finance, and Legueux Minister of Public Instruction.

General Mitre is near Buenos Ayres, with 10,000 men. Great anxiety has been expressed by the government troops in favor of Mitre's apprehension.
