Massachusetts. BOSTON, January 19.—Balloting for United States Senator in both branches of the Massachusetts Legislature commenced today. The first ballot in the Senate resulted as follows: Dawes, 18; Abbott, 17; Hoar, 5; Adams, 1; R. H. Dana, Jr., 1; N. P. Banks, 1. The second ballot produced the same result.

In the House the first ballot resulted as follows: Whole number of votes 230; necessary for choice 116. Dawes had 83, Jonathan G. Abbott 70, Hoar 32, Charles Francis Adams 14, Charles Dawes Jr. 2, Alexander H. Bullock 2, Wendell Phillips 2, William Gaston 1. The second ballot, in the House gave Dawes 103, Abbott 83, Hoar 32, Adams 14, Dana 1, and Banks 1. The result of this vote has encouraged Dawes' friends. As compared with last year, Dawes gained 100 votes, while Abbott has gained 10 over Curtis' vote.

Rhode Island. PROVIDENCE, January 19.—The General Assembly met to-day. The Governor's annual message is confined entirely to State affairs.

Two ballots were taken for United States Senator, without an election. Burnside leads.

Delaware. DOVER, January 19.—Governor Cochran was inaugurated at noon to-day. The oath was administered by Willard Saulsbury, Chancellor.

A vote will be taken for United Senator in both houses to-morrow. Bayard will be re-elected.

Tennessee. NASHVILLE, January 19.—The two houses of the Legislature balloted separately for United States Senator.

In the Senate the vote stood: Johnson 6, Stephen A. Foster 5, East 3, Sawyer 2, Quarles 2, Ewing 1, Kennedy 1. The results of the second and third ballots were the same as the first.

In the House no nominations were made, and but one ballot had. Johnson received 21, Stephens 11, Brown 11, Bates 11, Quarles 3, Ewing 6, Sawyer 6, Brownlow 2, Hawkins 1. Both Houses adjourned until to-morrow.

Santander Arrived. SANTANDER, January 19.—The Spanish squadron has arrived at Laranz and is making preparations for vigorous action. Its commanders have been ordered to exact revenge from the Carlists' inhumanity to the crew and the Guevay and punishment of her assassins. Germany is entirely satisfied with the result.

London Times Fined for Libel. LONDON, January 19.—The London Times has been mulcted in £500 for libel. The Emma mine swindle entered in the question.

Military Movements in Cuba. HAVANA, January 19.—The following official information is published in the journal: The insurgents, commanded by Martinez Gomez, recently landed at the mouth of the San Juan river, and retired during the night. Three battalions of Spanish troops started in pursuit. Gomez, Sangre and Sanchez sent a detachment of 100 men to the Zaza river on the fourteenth. At Past Estano they met with a repulse from a Spanish detachment there, and immediately retreated, killing twenty killed, the Spaniards lost six killed.

The movements of the Spanish force commanded by Generals Espando and Valera have obliged the insurgents to divide into two bodies. One is near the Zaza, and the other near the Trinidad river, and both are subdivided into small squads. The author's view is that the Spanish force in the Ciego Villas district contained 1,000 men, and their activity will not leave the insurgents a moment's rest until defeated or forced to retreat. The troops escape in this direction may soon be impossible for them. The vessels of the navy watch closely all places where expeditions from abroad can be effected. The Cape Verde islands have been planted with impunity; he expected no resistance and hoped many men would join him.
