AN ACT Fixing the fees of the clerks of the district courts throughout the State (the parish of Orleans excepted), and providing the manner of collecting the same.

SECTION 1. Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives of the State of Louisiana in General Assembly convened, That the clerks of the several district courts throughout the State (the parish of Orleans excepted) shall be entitled to demand and receive the following fees of office:

For indexing, registering and filing petition, ten cents.

For indexing, registering and filing answer, ten cents.

For copying all instruments of writing not otherwise provided for, each one hundred words, five cents.

For filing citation, with seal and certificate, fifty cents.

For copying of citation, with seal and certificate, forty cents.

For issuing attachment, and seal, seventy cents.

For issuing order of seizure, with seal, fifty cents.

For issuing writ of certiorari, with seal, seventy-five cents.

For issuing writ of habeas corpus, with seal, and the proceedings thereon, no charge shall be made by the clerk or sheriff, except in civil cases.

For issuing writ of mandamus, with seal, seventy-five cents.

For issuing writ of distraints, with seal, seventy-five cents.

For issuing subpoena duces tecum, with seal, fifty cents.

For issuing subpoenas for witnesses, with seal, fifty cents.

For copying of depositions, with seal and certificate, fifty cents.

For issuing writ of possession, with seal, fifty cents.

For each order of partition, with seal, fifty cents.

For entering final judgment, with seal, fifty cents.

For entering judgment of appeal, with seal and certificate, fifty cents.

For copying of citation, with seal and certificate, forty cents.

For issuing writ of attachment to bring person into court, with seal, forty cents.

For issuing venire facias in each case in which a jury may be prayed for in the district court, to be charged to the clerk, and upon filing the petition, thirty-five cents.

For swearing jury, twenty-five cents.

For entering final judgment, with seal, fifty cents.

For every interlocutory judgment, no matter how many parties, thirty cents.

For every order of court entered on the minutes of the court, not otherwise provided for, fifteen cents.

For filing and registering returns on all writs, ten cents.

For setting aside for trial and setting the same on, ten cents.

For every certificate and seal of court to all other records or documents other than those herein specified, ten cents.

For notices to creditors of insolvents to attend on the trustee of the estate of the insolvent, ten cents.

For taking and filing bonds, in all cases where required by law, fifty cents.

For recording and registering deeds of conveyance for property sold and transferred by sheriff, for each hundred words, fifteen cents.

For entering satisfaction of judgment, seventy-five cents.

For every commission to take testimony of witnesses, or answers to interrogatories, with seal, one dollar.

For recording the petition, answer and judgment, in each case, fifteen cents for every hundred words.
