Notified that the Modus Vivendi Must Stand.

SALISBURY'S POINTED ANSWER

The Cabinet Takes Action and the Position of the United States is Cabled to England's Premier.

WASHINGTON, March 9.—Lord Salisbury has been informed that his latest proposition in regard to the Behring sea is not satisfactory to the United States. This is the result of Tuesday's cabinet meeting, when the subject was gone over fully.

The proposition as it came from the British foreign office was couched in phrases seeking to make out that it was only a modification of the modus vivendi which was in operation last year.

The points considered at the meeting were that unless the catch of seals is restricted, as under the present modus, to which Salisbury announced he will not agree, the race of seals will be nothing left to arbitrate about.

Moreover the end of the modus vivendi between Great Britain and the United States might lead to the seizure of Canadian sealers in the sea, over which the United States government claims exclusive jurisdiction, and such seizures might result in serious complications and, in a remote contingency, in actual hostilities.

Salisbury's Argument. Lord Salisbury in his proposition had called attention to the fact that in making the arrangement for the modus vivendi last year he had distinctly stated it was a temporary arrangement.

He holds that there was consequently no ground for the United States to assume that Great Britain was willing to extend it over a period of two years. The seal crop, he argues, is like a meadow, which must be mown yearly.

The conditions of last year's crop may be entirely different from those which prevail this year, but unless the grass is mown it goes to waste.

Following this line of argument Lord Salisbury undertakes to show that if seal-killing be entirely prohibited it simply results in a loss to everybody. He magnanimously allows that the United States has the same rights as other countries to kill the seals on the high seas.
