IN SEPARATING MAN AND WIFE

The Crop for '93 Promises to Be Large. Legalized Free Love—Divorces for \$5 Apiece.

Chicago, Sept. 1.—"Do you think that during the world's fair," I asked a judge of one of the Chicago courts today, "that you will have any noticeable increase in the amount of applicants for release from the married state?"

The divorce feature of Chicago life is interesting. It has received much attention from the paragrapher and the funny man of the pictorial papers that people may think it a subject that has been greatly exaggerated.

The nineteen judges who hear divorces are none of them fond of the task. Frequently enough the people who apply for them are well-to-do, neatly dressed, and many handsome women are to be seen on the witness stand, but by far the largest proportion of the applicants are foreigners or ordinary people and sometimes of such mediocre quality as to make of the court room, where fifty to one hundred applicants are crowded together, little less than a cattle pen.
