

ED TROY IS GUILTY

Of Deadly Assault Upon Police Officer Tatroe.

HIS ATTORNEY WILL APPEAL

A Large Crowd of Friends Waited Till Late Last Night to Learn the Jury's Decision.

Ed Troy was found guilty of deadly assault in the superior court at 10:30 last night. The testimony in the case was closed at noon and the arguments and the judge's charge filled the afternoon until 4:45, when the jury retired. The penalty for the crime may be as high as ten years imprisonment.

Mr. Maynard immediately asked for thirty days in which to appeal the case to the supreme court or move for a new trial. Mr. Maynard says he has great confidence in the innocence of his client and he will fight it to the end.

A large crowd of Troy's friends filled the court room until the verdict was rendered. This is the second of the "hobo" gang to be convicted.
