

HE IS STILL ALIVE

A. J. Nyman of Bangor Swallows Considerable Morphine

BUT HE WILL RECOVER

His Life Despaired of at First—His Heart Had Almost Stopped Beat—Gang and He Had Turned Blue.

A. J. Nyman, one of the best known residents of Bangor, Michigan, and a member of the Masonic fraternity, who is known all over the state, took an overdose of morphine in the Beckal house on Lonia street early yesterday morning. He came to the Beckal house about 11 o'clock Tuesday evening, and was assigned to room 10. He did not appear for breakfast and it was not discovered that he was still in his room until afternoon. His door was opened and he was found in a moribund condition, while a bottle of morphine near by told the story of his condition. Dr. Green and Dr. Egan were called. They did all that could be done for the sufferer, but thought he would die in a short time. Later in the day Dr. C. E. Patterson was told of the case and was informed that the patient up to the other doctors had given the patient up to die. Having a remedy which he considered better than those ordinarily used, he went to the house and administered his remedy. Later Mr. Nyman showed a decided improvement, and there was a controversy over whose medicine had done the good work. At 10 o'clock last evening a man from Bangor who happened to be in the city, heard of the case, visited the hotel and had a nurse sent for to attend the patient. He appeared at that time to be rapidly recovering, though his breathing was short and spasmodic. At 10 o'clock last night his brother, C. Nyman, arrived from Bangor. He says there is no reason why Mr. Nyman should commit suicide. He owns 200 acres of land and was happy so far as was known. He believes the drug was taken by mistake. Mr. Nyman is a former member of the lodge, Bangor and is one of the first men in that village. At 11 o'clock this morning he was still improving and was able to move his eyelids and his hands a little. It is believed he will recover. The man's father, owner of the Bangor water works, he is about 50 years old and has a wife but no children.
