**TIDINGS FROM SCANDINAVIA**

**Interesting News from Sweden, Norway and Denmark.**

**BLOWING UP OF STREET CARS**

Practice Continues in Stockholm and Vicinity in Spite of the Most Vigorous Alertness on the Part of the Police—No Great Damage Has Thus Far Resulted and No One Has Been Seriously Injured by the Explosions.

**SWEDEN.**

The attempts to blow up street cars in Stockholm continue and in spite of the most vigorous alertness on the part of the police, it seems impossible to check this nefarious practice. There have been at least five different attempts, which are of a similar nature to those reported in our last letter, viz., to place a bomb on the track, thus seeking to blow up or wreck cars. The other evening while a car on the so called red line was passing between Haga and Hagaland, a number of heavy rocks came crashing through the windows, but peculiarly enough none of the passengers were injured. One of the rocks grazed the head of a woman passenger and had it struck her it would have killed her instantly, judging from its size and from the force with which it came crashing through the window. A bomb was placed on the street car tracks on the Narva road near Linne street, but it only half exploded and one was injured.

**State News.**

**REPORT OF THE CONDITION OF The First National Bank OF PRINCETON.**

Another victim of Mrs. Belle Guinness, arch-murderess, has been identified as Tonia Peter Lien of Rushford, Minn. Samuel P. Lien, who recently returned from a sea cruise of three years in the Pacific ocean, identified a watch that had been found in the burned ruins of the Guinness house as one that belonged to his brother, Tonia.

Frank Sadler of Ely, a miner, was found guilty of murder in the first degree in the district court at Virginia. It took the jury twenty-five hours to agree. Sadler killed Lawrence Kopre at Ely, on August 9, last. He had quarreled with Tony Jenko a companion. He saw Jenko enter Kopre's house and knocked at the door, thinking Jenko would appear. Kopre responded instead and Sadler felled him with an ax. Kopre died a few days later.

J. W. Gregg, aged 83, while getting the mail from a Duluth train at Cass Lake was run down by a boy driving a fast team and perhaps fatally injured. Gregg was in partnership with James J. Hill in the wood and coal business forty-five years ago. He was once a prominent contractor and constructed several big buildings in the twin cities. When the hard times came he was left penniless. His wife died several years ago in the southern part of the state and he moved to Cass Lake twelve years ago to live with a son. The son died seven years ago and then the old man took the position of mail carrier to make a living.
