

PROPOSED Amendments TO THE Constitution OF MINNESOTA.

Hon. Peter E. Hanson, Secretary of State—Sir: Pursuant to Chapter 157 of the General Laws of 1887...

Synopsis of Amendments to the Constitution of the State of Minnesota Proposed by the Legislature of the State of Minnesota at the General Session in 1903...

Pursuant to the provisions of Section 32 (a) of Article 4 of the Constitution, the Legislature, by an act approved April 18th, 1903...

Section 1. The railroad company owning or operating any line of railway situated within or over any territory of this state, shall during the year 1905...

Section 2. The term "gross earnings" derived from the operation of such line of railway within this state, as used in section 1 of this act...

Section 3. All acts and parts of acts not inconsistent herewith regulating the payment, collection, time of payment, enforcement or reports involving the amount of taxes upon such lines of railway...

Section 4. Upon failure to pay the amount of such taxes legally due upon the date heretofore provided by law for the payment thereof...

Section 5. Before any railroad company shall be heard to contest or continue to contest the validity of this act or any part thereof...

This act provides for an increase in the amount of taxes collected by the state upon the property of the railroads situated within the state from three per cent of the gross earnings...

By an act of the legislature of the State of Minnesota, approved March 23rd, 1903, known as Chapter 25 of the General Laws of Minnesota 1903...
