CORN CAKE FOR TWO.—Sift a cupful of cornmeal into a bowl or tin, make a hole in it, put in salt, soda or shortening, as for biscuit, break in two eggs, stir with a strong spoon until the eggs are well broken and mixed, then with new butter-milk or sour milk, make into a batter.

PACKING EGGS IN SALT.—To preserve eggs it is necessary to keep the interior free from contact with the air, and also to prevent the moisture from evaporating.
