Pneumatic Tubes in Paris.

It would appear from some recently issued statistics of the French telegraph service that the system of closed or letter telegrams is already largely in use in Paris. This method of communication consists in blowing the telegram paper itself through a pneumatic tube instead of manipulating its contents verbally along the telegraph wire; and it appears that the pneumatic system at present at work in Paris has a total length of 77,600 metres, and that it is worked from six stations, at which are located steam engines having a total power of 153 horses, besides six water motors. The service comprises a main system with double line, at which terminates seven supplementary systems with branches, trains running every three minutes on the main system, and every five minutes on the supplementary systems. The system was introduced on the 1st of May 1880, and it is now possible to communicate from one part of Paris to another and receive a reply back for little more than half a franc, or about one fourth of the cost of an ordinary telegraphed message to London. The extent to which the pneumatic telegraph is used in Paris may be judged from the fact that something approaching 400,000 dispatches of all kinds pass over the system every month.


