HONOLULU, JULY 28, 1869.

H. B. M.'s Frigate Galatea arrived on the 21st instant from Tahiti, via Hilo.

The only merchant vessel which arrived during the past week is the Hawaiian bark R. W. Wood, with an assorted cargo, from Bremen, after a long passage of 135 days.

The British brig Byzantium has cleared for Victoria, with salt, sugar, molasses, etc. The Alaska is loading for Portland, and will have quick dispatch. The Ethan Allen has discharged her cargo, and will be laid on for San Francisco.

The steamer Idaho will be due from San Francisco on the 2nd of August, and will leave for that port on Saturday, the 7th. It is probable that some vessel chartered for the Am. Guano Company, may bring us a mail prior to the steamer's arrival.

The Light-house, erected by the Government, was lighted up on Monday, and will, no doubt, be of great advantage to the foreign and coasting shipping arriving off this port during the night.

Attention is called to a "Notice to Mariners," issued by the Interior Department, regarding the bearings and altitude of the light.
