Scientific Agriculture.

Shipbuilding in Great Britain in 1881.

In the annual review of the London Soci-ety for the Improvement of the Steam Navigation, the year 1881 shows an unprecedented amount of shipbuilding business, and it is estimated that about a million tons gross register has been launched during the year.

During '81 the number of vessels built was 77, against 76 in 1880, and 75 in 1879. The tonnage was 116,227 tons, against 112,227 tons in 1880, and 107,227 tons in 1879.
