

LATEST FOREIGN NEWS.

By the Wm. St. Louis, which arrived in port here on the 9th inst., dates of the 28th ult. have been received. Following is a condensed account of news from various portions of the world:

The labor troubles are creating considerable uneasiness in France. Another comet has been discovered, eight degrees East of the great one.

Small-pox rages at Bogota, Colombia, there being 30 cases in the hospital. The editor of the Irish Nation at New York has been arrested for libel, at the instance of August Belmont.

Seven students of Bowdoin College have been fined \$2,700 for having freshmen. The French Chambers will meet November 9th. Admiral High Young Parvianoe, E.S.N., retired, is dead, age 92.

The first snow of the season fell at New York, Saturday, October 23d. A typhoon destroyed the greater part of Manila, Philippine Islands, September 25th, and beached thirteen vessels.

A Spanish steamer from New York for the West Indies was towed into Fortezza Menore October 23d with only three men on board, the captain, mate and six men having died of yellow fever.

Mozroe Chief trotted two miles at Lexington, Ky., lately, in 1:25, beating the best former record by two and a half seconds.

H. W. Grannis, who beat his wife brutally and pleaded guilty to a charge of battery, was sentenced by an Oakland Police Judge October 25th, to pay a fine of \$250, with the alternative of 300 days in jail. Grannis had only lately arrived from Honolulu.

She was built in New Brunswick in 1890 and was consequently thirteen years old. Her registered tonnage, according to Lloyd's, was 807 tons. Her cargo was 1,115 tons of Wallaseed coal, valued at \$6,700, and was insured in Liverpool. The crew were twenty-five days at sea in open boats.
