

KAUAI NOTES.

Interesting Happenings on the Garden Island—Personal and Other Matters.

Dr. Campbell has returned from Nihaui, where, we are sorry to say, his excessive attentions to master Gay, were unavailing.

Mr. Francis Gay came back from Honolulu this week, accompanied by Messrs. Baldwin and Walsh. The latter gentlemen have drawn up plans for the new mill which is to be erected at Makawili.

Mr. Emerson visited Lihue this week to conduct the semi-annual convention of Hawaiian pastors. The meeting was held in Lihue for the first time in ten years.

The quarterly examinations of Sunday Schools took place a week ago. The native children repeated the texts perfectly, and answered all the questions with much clearness.

These rumors says that Miss Emily Kawaha, the assistant teacher in the Kapaia school, is soon to be married.

Miss Mary Frobenberg of Hanalei, was married on Sunday, September 20th, to Mr. John Radway, book-keeper for the Hanalei plantation.

Kaui, from Kekaha to Hanalei will send its representatives to the Glade ball. Many guests were invited from this island, and those who have been able to accept the invitations, are anticipating much pleasure.

A serious accident, that might have proved fatal, occurred near Hanamaulu on Tuesday. A native boy about 18 years of age, a steady reliable lad, was driving a large dray.

Planting is still continued, although we are almost through. The weather has been propitious, and frequent showers have fallen on the young cane.

Nineteen Portuguese families left here about a week ago, six of whom have settled in Lihue, while the other thirteen have gone to Honolulu, some to remain there, and some to leave the country.

Progress of the Oahu Railway. There have now arrived for the Oahu Railroad Co. this week 22,755 ties or as many as will lay an additional eight miles of road—21,300 of these are red-wood ties from the coast, and 1,455 are of oia timber from the district of Puna, Hawaii.


