

TRY TO SHIFT BLAME

Morse Also Contradicts Oler's Testimony Wherein Oler Testified to Pressure of Morse For a Big Loan.

NEW YORK, Oct. 30.--Morse today, in his testimony, contradicted the Curtis testimony repudiating the evidence of a \$10,000 loan alleged to have been arranged with Curtis. Begins a Whirlwind Finish in Taft's State to Close With a Big Meeting This Evening at Cleveland.

EXPECTS TO WIN OHIO

Feels Confident of Carrying the State Will Make a Number of Speeches in Towns Along the Wabash.

CLEVELAND, Ohio, Oct. 30.--Bryan is today in a whirlwind tour of northern Ohio. His special was here five minutes this morning. A few railroad men greeted and shook hands with the candidate, who said: "I am feeling as well as when I started the campaign. My voice is strong and health is fine. I have been well received at all the meetings and no discouraging reports were heard anywhere. I think that we will carry Ohio." The itinerary includes a dash from Toledo west along the Wabash railroad to Napoleon, Ohio, then returning to Toledo for a big noon day speech.
