### MILLIONAIRE TO SPEAK SUNDAY

Hon. W. L. Roach, of Muscatine to be Speaker at Big Meeting For Men at Grand Opera House.

#### HE IS A GIFTED ORATOR

Committee Asking That Prominent Debater, Politician, and Business Man Be Given Large Hearing.

If the masses were as familiar with the ability of the man who will be the speaker on that date, as the committee, it is certain that it would be an overflow meeting. 
