HORSE AND WAGON OUT IN THE RIVER

Party of Men and Clerks Searched All Around the Premises and Finally Hear the Animal in Water.

Last night the Keokuk was a little late in arriving from Quincy on account of a big freight business which it did between here and the Illinois city. Three men were waiting in the office of the Mississippi Coal and Ice Company's office at the foot of Johnson street and were awaiting the arrival of the boat there because of it being too cold to remain outside last night and the snow which fell for a short time was blinding.

The men had driven to the wharf in a one horse wagon and had left the animal tied securely as they thought outside the north warehouse door and retired to the inner office of the Coal and Ice company to warm up by the stove.

Presently one of the men arose and said he would go to look after the horse and see that the animal was all right as it had been over an hour since they had driven to the landing and tied the animal. The man left the house and walked out to where the animal had been tied but what was his surprise on arriving at the tying place to find that the good steed had vanished and no traces of it could be

found. Excitedly the man ran back to the office where the other two men and several clerks of the office were seated and frightened all by suddenly bursting in upon the bunch and breathlessly telling them that the horse, wagon and all had disappeared.

Horse in the River.

Searching parties were immediately formed, all to go in different directions and report in a half hour at the office and tell what they had discovered of the horse and wagon. The parties separated and searched diligently for the rig that had disappeared shortly before. The men went all around the warehouse and scoured up and down the levee and Water street. One of the parties listening intently thought he heard a noise out in the river as of some great whale splashing around and calling the rest of the searchers' attention to it, they all decided that it must be the strayed horse, so a skiff was secured and after rowing out into the river for about a quarter of a block the animal was found quietly wading toward the Illinois shore which was home to the horse. The water was not very deep along here, it was not difficult to turn the head of the animal toward shore again, when it was found that the only accident to the outfit was that some of the harness was broken and the bed of the wagon slightly dampened by the river washing into it.

The Keokuk landed shortly after the horse was brought ashore and securing their goods from the boat the three men in the wagon felt for home.

ADVOCATE ABOLISHMENT OF STREET LIGHTS

C. L. Becker Says to Save \$10,000 Per Year on Lights and Use It on Street Improvements.

One Keokuk man believes that the Keokuk Lantern club is such a good thing that the city could afford to do away with the electric lighting system and save the \$10,000 per year paid for the service.

He puts the proposition up to the people that the city cancel its contract with the lighting company and use the \$10,000 saved, in improving the streets. Here is his idea.

To the Editor of The Gate City: I have been watching The Gate City in regard to the Lantern Club. I so far have not joined it because I have advocated the use of lanterns for several years, not because we had no electric lights, nor moonshine, but because the large untrimmed trees, some in all parts of the city, but more especially in the First ward where at least half of the streets and sidewalks would be dark, to say nothing about the accident at the power house. The city pays out say \$800 per month for light, including the light inspectors—\$9,600 per year.

If we can do without the electric light for say two months, what is the reason we can't do without it for twelve months and save all this money and put it on the streets, which would put them in good orders and then keep them so. The light only burns on an average of half the night any way and of course we now have our lanterns and if we have to go out the first part of the night, use them. Then the last half of the night stay at home, where nearly everybody ought to be. What say you taxpayers?
