The Government and Publishing House Seem to Disagree on Spelling of That City.

A Keokuk man had an experience yesterday afternoon at the postoffice which shows that there is a disagreement in the spelling of the city Pittsburg. Is there an "H" at the end of the word, or does the word end with a "G"?

The disagreement is between the postoffice and the Methodist Protestant Board of Publication, 422 Fifth avenue, Pittsburg—"G" or "GH." Although there is no real disagreement as to the spelling of the word, the postoffice spells it with a "G" only, and would not send a money order with the word Pittsburg spelled with an "H" at the end.

In all the printed matter sent out by the big publication house the word Pittsburg is spelled with an "H" at the end, although this is possible the first time this matter has ever been brought before the attention of Keokuk people.
