

MEEK BROTHERS ARE IN TROUBLE

Reported That the Well Known and Influential Bonaparte Family is in Financial Difficulties.

STOKER USED MONEY

A Temporary Embarrassment is Said to Have Been Caused by Backing the New Invention.

The following from the Keosauqua Democrat will be of interest to Keokuk friends of the Meek family of Bonaparte:

It has been known or some time that the Meek Bros. and the Meek Bros. Co. of Bonaparte were financially embarrassed. The woolen mills have not been in operation for several months past and only a small force has been employed in the plants factory.

Meek Bros Co. is a corporation. It owns and operated everything pertaining to the manufacturing of woolen goods and clothing, including all buildings, machinery, etc. The company is capitalized for \$200,000 and has a considerable number of stockholders, although the Meek Bros., consisting of H. H. Meek, B. F. Meek and Kirk Meek, held a majority of the stock they managed the business of the company.

The Stoker Investment. The liabilities of the Meek Bros. individually are said to be quite large. Two or three years ago they became interested in a stoker to be attached to railroad locomotives to supply their furnaces with coal. The stoker has been thoroughly tested and is a success in every way. It seems certain that it is only a matter of a short time when it will make its owners good fortunes. However they have met with delay after delay in placing the stock of the stoker company and beginning the manufacture of the machines. But they have finally disposed of a majority of the stock to a New York syndicate in which Theodore P. Shontz is a leading member and an office has been opened in Chicago, in charge of Mr. Harrigan, vice president of the company, to handle the business. Mr. Harrigan resigned the presidency of the Brotherhood of Locomotive Firemen of the United States to accept a position with the stoker company.
