DEATH TODAY OF MRS. HEASLIP

Beloved Wife of Henry A. Heaslip and Daughter of E. R. Drake Passed Away at St. Joseph's Hospital.

NEWS SUDDEN TO MANY

Only Few of Friends Were Aware That She Was in Serious Condition—All Speak Highly of Her.

Mrs. Ella Cornelius Heaslip, beloved wife of Henry A. Heaslip and daughter of E. R. Drake, a venerable citizen of Keokuk, who has passed the eightieth mile stone of life, died shortly after eight o'clock this morning at St. Joseph's hospital.

Born in East. Ella Cornelius came to brighten the home of Mr. and Mrs. E. R. Drake on November 11, 1862, when that couple, later residents of Keokuk, were living in Catskill, New York.

Her marriage to Henry A. Heaslip, for many years a member of the firm of Collins-Heaslip Company, occurred five years ago. To this union no children were born.

Hundreds of copies of The Gate City are being mailed out of town these days by Keokuk people to friends and relatives, giving them the information about the water power.

Fred Hilpert, Jr., who together with Henry Brandt of Mt. Hamill, Iowa, closed the deal Wednesday for the purchase of the Beck farm of 560 acres at Mt. Clara, stated today that the purchase price, was \$42,000.

The Standard Fire Insurance Co. ordered several hundred copies of the "Extra" Gate City of Saturday noon which contained the water power history, to be sent to all of the agents of the company in this vicinity.

Clem Ross, the young fellow with whisky fits who was in a serious condition at the police station Saturday evening, had another spell last night and it was necessary to summon a doctor.

M. J. Burke, a trustee of the Knights of Columbus, stated to a reporter this morning that the council, would not have to vacate its present home on account of water power boom.

The Daily Gate City gave Keokuk a tremendous amount of advertising through the issuance of its extra edition. Copies of the paper were sent all over the world.

Many persons are walking across the ice today and yesterday there were many who took the frozen water way of getting to and from the Illinois shore. In a number of places air holes occur, but the ice is strong enough to hold a horse and sleigh.

A meeting of the Keokuk bar has been called for Tuesday morning at 10 o'clock, to pass resolutions of respect for the late Judge H. H. Trimble, the oldest member of the bar.

The annual meeting of the Humane society is to be held tomorrow evening at 7:45 o'clock in the rooms of the Commercial club, at which time officers will be elected for the ensuing year.

The Nauvoo Rustler is a hustler and got out an extra on Saturday announcing the water power. It consisted of a yellow handbill with the picture of a crowing rooster, with the following announcement: "Hurrah! for the water power. Word has been received from the east that the building of the water power is assured and work will commence immediately."

There were a number of Keokuk citizens who vigorously have been skeptical about the water power project and freely predicting that it never would be built. Those few citizens have now crawled in a hole and pulled the hole in after them.

Dr. H. E. W. Barnes, who will be remembered by many of the Keokuk doctors, and who is now a resident of Santa Ana, Calif., sends to the Gate City a copy of the Los Angeles Times, containing 220 pages. It is the annual mid-winter edition of that paper.
