

PLEASURE BOATS COMING NORTH

The Palatial Steamers J. S. and W. W. are Working their Way up Stream Giving Excursions.

HERE JUNE THE 17th

First Excursion of the Season Out of Keokuk on the J. S. Will be June 17 by the Unitarians.

The handsome steamer "J. S." which has been operating all winter southern waters, left New Orleans Monday, May 2, on its journey arriving the next day at Plaquemine, where it opened its first late with an excursion.

Many Excursion Trips. The object of Captain Streckfus, in charge of the boat, is to put the steamer to good advantage on its trip north, having many excursion dates at towns along the Ohio, Tennessee, Cumberland and Illinois rivers, and finally after again reaching the Father of Waters will continue on its way to the local port. The boat has been repaired recently in the south at a large expense, and is considered by many to be the most beautiful boat on the Mississippi.

Overhaul the W. W. The steamer "W. W." which is now at Paducah, Ky., being overhauled and repaired, will open the season next Sunday at that place with an excursion, after which it will work its way up the Ohio, making the different towns along that stream. The boat will then sail down the Ohio to Cairo, Ill., and up the Mississippi, arriving here on May 29.

SHERLOCK HOLMES DID GREAT WORK

Paris Detective Went into 800 Houses Before He Got Clue to the Murder.

PADRIS, May 7.—M. Hamard, chief of detectives in Paris accomplished one of the cleverest pieces of detective work in recent criminal annals in the arrest of the murderer of a poor street girl, Elisa Vandamme, whose atrocious murder had baffled the police for six weeks. The girl's head was found in a sewer, and subsequently her hands, feet and other portions of her body were discovered in different places.

Hamard, with only the vaguest clue doggedly searched 800 houses, and finally found the key to the girl's room in the bureau of a former convict named Ferdinand, who had recently escaped from the penal colony in French Guinea.

When confronted with the evidence of his guilt Ferdinand broke down and confessed to cutting up and disposing of the body, but asserted that the girl had died from natural causes in his arms.


