

WASHINGTON, Nov. 11.—"Clean up" is the slogan at the capitol.

The count of postage stamps suggested a verification of all balances in the bureau. It was done and showed 2,056,047 sheets of blank paper and 31,166,600 sheets of printed work in various stages of manufacture.

Postage stamps ran up to \$7,521,708 sheets, containing a total of nearly 10,045,735,207 stamps. Of the higher priced postage stamps there were 42,392 at \$1 each; 697,787 at 50 cents and 16,093,989 at 15 cents.
