MAN REQUESTS

DEATH SENTENCE

Killed His Infant Son to Save It From the Terrors of the Future.

[United Press Leased Wire Service.] LONDON, Feb. 9.—Over his own protest, friends of Albert Reeves, the atheist who recently slew his infant son "to save him from the maelstrom of modern industrial life," today petitioned the home office to commute the prisoner's death sentence.

Reeves made an extraordinary plea when he was taken before the court. Refusing the services of a counsel, he calmly arose and said in a firm voice:

"Your Lordship, I am guilty. I am of perfectly sound mind and I knew what I was doing. I realize the gravity of the charge and I am ready to satisfy the law's demands. It is incumbent upon you to sentence me to death."

Donning the black cap, the judge passed sentence as the prisoner requested. He expressed the hope, however, that the home office would inquire into the man's sanity.
