MANN ACT GAME INSTEAD OF BADGER

Blackmailers Find Fertile Field For Operating on Rich Men.

[United Press Leased Wire Service.] CHICAGO, March 26.—The 'Mann act' game has replaced the old 'badger game' as a means of syndicalizing amorous men of wealth out of money according to statements made by federal white slave investigators.

'At least a dozen attempts to blackmail wealthy men by threatening prosecution under the white slave law have been reported to my office in the past year,' declared U. S. District Attorney Wilkerson today.

'The same scheme probably is being worked in many cities,' said Wilkerson. 'New York, I understand, is considered especially good ground because crossing the state line into Pennsylvania or New Jersey is a matter of but a few minutes ride.'



Steamer Black Hawk of Carnival City Packet Company Will Not Enter Trade Till May 1.



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
