Williamsburg, Kans., Wants to Know if We Have the Bones of "Young" or "Old" Chief Keokuk.

ONLY ONE IS RECOGNIZED

Casual Inquiry Here Fails to Find Anyone Who Ever Heard of Another Chief.

Did anyone in Keokuk ever hear of a "Young Chief" Keokuk? So far as this city has been concerned there has been but one "Chief" Keokuk.

Dear Sir: I am enclosing a clipping from the Williamsburg Star, published in a town near which is located the Greenwood cemetery, in which are buried many of the Sac and Fox Indians in the southeastern part of Franklin county, where once lived "Old Chief" Keokuk and his son, "Young Chief" Keokuk, who succeeded his father.

Will you please advise me which fact is true, or if you can not do so, turn this letter over to the man or woman who can, and send me a reply? I shall greatly appreciate this.

Casual inquiry by The Gate City yesterday revealed the fact that so far as is known here there was but one Chief Keokuk and he is the one whose bones repose in Rand park.

One of the prominent members of the D. A. R. chapter here, and one who was quite prominent in the monument work, declared that she had never heard of but one Chief Keokuk.

The clipping which has caused all this comment follows: Williamsburg Star: Roland Hanna and C. A. Peddicord while digging up some brush in the pasture belonging to Mr. Peddicord, ran on to the remains of an Indian chief.

They also found a portion of the blanket which had been all wool and was still preserved. A short piece of lariat rope lay by the remains.

COINCIDENCE IN RELIGIOUS DATE

Christian and Jewish Holy Days Will Come Together This Time Which is Unusual.

ONLY ONCE IN 9 YEARS

Good Friday and Feast of the Passover Will Fall on the Same Day This Year.

This year's religious calendar shows an unusual coincidence in that the Christian Good Friday and the Jewish feast of the Passover fall on the same day.

On account of the Christian church accepting the calendar of Pope Gregory in place of the lunar calendar of the Hebrews, these holidays are usually one week, sometimes two, and rarely, three weeks apart.

The Passover, which is redolent of the spring time and carries many pretty and interesting traditions of the Jews, begins next Friday evening and lasts seven days.

The feast, which is one of general thanksgiving and rejoicing, commemorates the release of the Jews from Egypt and their going into the wilderness in order to worship, in their own way, their God.

Services Start Friday. The eating of unleavened bread during the Passover holiday is in memory of the unleavened bread of the escaping Hebrews.

Another tradition has to do with the Red Sea which, the scriptures say, turned to land when the Hebrews desired to pass to escape from the army of Pharaoh.
