Lady Baltimore Cake

The Most Popular Cake This Season By Mrs. Janet McKenzie Hill, Editor of the Boston Cooking School Magazine

This is considered by many cooking authorities the finest cake that can be made, though in reality it is not at all difficult.

One cup butter; 2 cups granulated sugar; 1 cup milk; 1 teaspoonful rose water; 3 1/2 cups flour; 3 level teaspoonsful K. C. Baking Powder; whites of 6 eggs, beaten dry.

Frosting for Lady Baltimore Cake Three cups granulated sugar; 3 cups boiling water; 1/2 cup of eggs; 1 cup chopped nuts; 1 cup chopped walnuts; 5 figs cut in thin slices.

Stir the sugar and water until the sugar is dissolved, then let boil without stirring until the syrup from a spoon will spin a long thread; pour upon the whites of the eggs, beaten dry, beating constantly meanwhile.

Beat the butter and sugar together until the mixture is light and fluffy; add the egg whites, beating constantly.

When the affairs of Mead, Smith and Marsh were finally wound up the mill was placed on the market at a modest figure, and forming a partnership with F. C. A. Denkmann, the mill was purchased by making a small cash payment.

Still Lived at Coal Valley. Upon acquiring the mill Mr. Weyerhaeuser did not devote his entire time to manufacturing lumber, but continued in charge of the Coal Valley business.

Career of Frederick Weyerhaeuser

(Rock Island Union.) Frederick Weyerhaeuser was born in Neldersauheim, a village in the valley of the Rhine located not far from the city of Mainz, Nov. 21, 1834.

During those early days the log supply was in the hands of log drivers. It was a business by itself. The timber was cut, first on the Black river and then further to the north, rafted and brought down and sold to the mills.

Purchased Pine Lands. While investigating in this way he became convinced that it would be a good policy to acquire timberland. Mr. Denkmann saw too, that his idea was a good one.

When Mr. Weyerhaeuser undertook the purchase of pine lands in the north and took over the rafting business others followed in his wake.

Mr. Weyerhaeuser saw a solution of these difficulties in the formation of a logging company—a company which should be composed of the larger manufacturers and which would boom all of the logs for all of the owners and raft them.

Here, again, Mr. Weyerhaeuser showed his spirit of fairness. He insisted that a just and equitable rate should be made for the small mill owners. They should not be left out nor put out of business.

It was a delicate business, this separating, grading and pricing of logs, and the task was delegated to a committee of which Mr. Weyerhaeuser was chairman and executive head.
