

### PROMINENT WOMAN ON VISIT TO DAM

Mrs. W. P. Borland, Wife of Missouri Congressman is Shown Over Plant Here This Morning.

Mrs. William P. Borland, wife of Congressman Borland of Kansas City, Mo., was a visitor at the power plant of the Mississippi River Power company today. She was escorted over the works by a representative from the Industrial association.

Mrs. Borland has just recently been at Panama and her interest in the two greatest projects of the age is deep. She was much impressed by the Keokuk dam and the huge power house. It was far beyond her expectations, she declared.

Mrs. Borland was anxiously scanning the papers for news of her husband's fate at the Missouri primaries. Word that she received this morning was that his nomination was practically assured.

### JUDGE E. H. NORTON DIES IN MISSOURI

He was Father of Mrs. H. W. Hulskamp of This City, and Lived at Platte City.

The Hon. E. H. Norton, father of Mrs. Henry W. Hulskamp of this city, passed away last night at his home in Platte City, Mo. Decedent during his active life was a chief justice of the supreme bench of Missouri. He has been retired for several years, however, being 92 years old.

Yesterday afternoon Mrs. Hulskamp received a message saying that her father's condition was critical. She left immediately for Platte City. Last night at 10 o'clock a message was received by Mr. Hulskamp announcing the death of Judge Norton.

Judge Norton was a very prominent citizen of Platte City and of Missouri. He was exceedingly well known, and highly esteemed. For many years he served on the supreme bench of the state in the capacity of chief justice. He was born in November, 1821, and was 92 years old.


