—A marriage license was issued yesterday afternoon to Charles W. Brice, 21, Keokuk, and Blanche Ellen Bartholomew, 17, Keokuk. They were married by the Rev. John C. Sage.

—Prof. Henry S. Curtis, the playground expert from Olivet, Michigan, will be in Lee county again. Professor Curtis will address the people of Fort Madison tonight at a mass meeting.

—The serious illness of Judge Smith McPherson is a matter of regret to the local practitioners who knew him well. He has been confined to his home at Red Oak for a number of weeks.

—Federal court convened today at Des Moines. At this term of court it is understood that the indicted plumbers will have a trial. Special government agents have arrived to aid in the prosecution.

—The old Seventh street Baptist church at Seventh and Concert streets has been entirely torn down. This old landmark had quite a history during the years it served as a house of worship for the colored Baptists.

—The government lock closed Sunday night at midnight. Boats which need to be locked through to the upper or lower levels may do so for a few days, however, weather permitting, by adhering to the schedule prepared by the government and already published. Boats can be locked through from 8 a. m. to 4 p. m.

—A number of Keokuk policy holders will be interested in the following answer to an inquiry sent the Chicago Tribune: While reports of the Bankers Life company of Des Moines, published in insurance manuals, indicate that the old assessment policies will be kept in a class by themselves, which ultimately would necessitate an advance in rates, a letter from the auditor's department of the state of Iowa says that this is not the case. The letter says, "The old policy holders are not put in a class by themselves." It explains that many of these old policies will lapse and others will be exchanged for the new legal reserve policies, and that the great fund back of the decreasing number of old policies will furnish sufficient reserve for many years. Finally, "for the remaining few (if such exist) proper provision has been made by the company." This means that an increase in rates would become inevitable the remaining assessment policies will be carried at the expense of the legal reserve branch of the company instead of being compelled to carry themselves. According to this you are perfectly safe in continuing your old policies.
