PLAN IS SAID TO PREVENT WRECKS

Series of Tests Will be Made Under Auspices of the Burlington on Aurora Division, Beginning Next Month.

EXPERTS WILL BE THERE

Commerce Commission Men Will Watch This Test—Chicagoan is Inventor of System.

The Burlington railway on the first of March, on the main line tracks west of Aurora, Ill., will begin a series of tests of a device that it is claimed will prevent railway wrecks.

Hundreds of lives have been saved by the introduction of steel passenger coaches on the railroads. Now the interstate commerce commission proposes to find some device, that will make derailments, rear and head-end collisions and wrecks impossible.

Anatol Gollas, a Chicagoan, is the first inventor in the country to procure an official investigation. The reward comes after three years of work on an automobile train control and recorder.

H. D. Lyon, inspector of safety appliances for the commission, has arrived in Chicago to prepare for a month's study of the new device. A number of miles of track near Aurora have been equipped so that a full and complete test may be made.

The inventor referring to his device made the following statement: "In my device the control of the train is in the hands of the engineer only so long as they tend to business and watch the signals.

The commission, where the invention has merit, will put the device on a recommended list.

PRINCESS THEATRE SAFE BLOWN OPEN

Four Men Divide About \$3,000 in Cash for the Work of One Night.

[United Press Leased Wire Service.] CHICAGO, Feb. 23.—Four yeggmen early today dynamited the safe at William Brady's Princess theatre, in the loop district, and escaped with about \$3,000 in cash.

The men apparently sat through last night's performance and then hid in an alcove of one of the boxes after the curtain rang down. About two o'clock, as Watchman Christopher Messer was making his rounds, he was seized and bound and gagged.

Only when Messer freed himself and dashed into the South Clark street station an hour later, did the police know of the robbery.

The statement of the United States treasury for January 20, shows that the government's yearly income is \$35,356,600 less than a year ago, while its yearly outgo is \$12,536,000 greater for the same period, and the surplus in the treasury is \$47,894,000 less than a year ago.
