

### TRAIN AND BUGGY CRASH ON BRIDGE

Woman and Two Children, Occupants of Buggy, Thrown Out, But None Are Seriously Hurt.

### HORSE WAS FRIGHTENED

Animal Became Unmanageable and Accident Resulted—Occurred on Des Moines River Bridge.

A southbound C. B. & Q. train struck a buggy on the southern end of the Des Moines river bridge at 9:30 Saturday morning, damaging the buggy, but not injuring the occupants.

According to the report of the accident received by Palmer Trimble, attorney for the C. B. & Q. at this place, the accident was caused by Mrs. Newton losing control of her horse which became frightened and swerved into the path of the train.

Mrs. Newton was driving toward this city when the accident occurred, but when her horse became frightened, it turned around and faced the opposite direction, leaving the rear wheels of the buggy on the tracks.
