SENTENCED ON TWO CHARGES

George Davis, Colored Gets Sixty Days in County Jail for Theft of Bicycle and Tools.

PROPERTY RECOVERED

William Kent Had Good Time Here Since Thankgiving on Fifty Dollars—Fine Takes Last Cent.

George Davis, colored, was given thirty days each in two larceny counts in Judge McNamara's court this morning. He was accused in informations filed against him of stealing tools valued at \$5 from George Conley on November 19, and a bicycle valued at \$15, belonging to Ernest Kiann, a mail carrier, on November 29.

Davis pleaded guilty to the first charge, but said that another man had stolen the wheel and given it to him to dispose of. All of the stolen property was recovered and returned to its owners.

Davis told the court that he had been working at the smelter works and was also a chicken picker. He said he came here from Fort Madison and that his home was in Shelbyville.

Fifty Dollars Worth of Good Time. "It's my falling judge," said William Kent, a periodic visitor from Illinois, when arraigned in court this morning on the charge of drunkenness. He was fined costs.

Kent said that he had saved his money and come to Keokuk with \$50 in his pocket for a good time. He was dead broke this morning, but was finally able to raise the \$2.35 and go on his way, which is back to the farm where he will labor until, as he says, he hears the white lights calling again.
