John Young, ninety-three years of age and a pioneer citizen of Warsaw, passed away in Keokuk at the home of his daughter Mrs. Frank Waugh, 1217 Concert street, at 4:00 o'clock on Monday afternoon.

At the age of twenty-four he left his native home and came across the ocean to the new world, settling in St. Louis on July 3, 1848. After residing there for a short time he removed to Warsaw, Ill., and had lived in that city for sixty-eight years. He was a cooper by trade and was an industrious and energetic worker, proving himself efficient in all his undertakings and commanding the respect of his employes.

In the year 1852 he was united in marriage to Miss Katherine Rucky and to this union were born ten children, of which number eight survive. Mrs. Young has been dead for several years.
