THE CRIMES OF KIMPTON.

How he bribed Speaker Moses and stole the money to do it.

[Charlesston Correspondence New York World.]

The people here, who had begun to settle down to the enjoyment of an uneventful and quiet State campaign, have become great pleasure and excitement over the news of the arrest of Hiram H. Kimpton, late financial agent, and his prospect for special extradition to the capital of our State, to be put on trial for the serious crimes alleged against him. To recount the various robberies of the resources of South Carolina committed by this man Kimpton, in connection with his financial agency, and the financial board—Scott, Chamberlain, and Parker, aided and abetted on many occasions by such men as Patterson, Moses, Worthington, and other statesmen of that ilk—would require more space than this journal can afford.

At each session of the general assembly, when bills of a doubtful character were to be passed, Kimpton was the chief lobbyist for the State, and he was not infrequently the bribes to the willing and hungry legislators. His appearance here at the beginning of every legislative term was the harbinger of plenty for those who had votes to sell, and his name was mentioned among the names of the members of the legislature, which really belong to the State, and which were afterwards charged up to any account which was most convenient, all of these with respect to their duties, the appropriation of the treasury and the increase of the State debt were effected. Notable among these were the bills to redeem the bills of the Bank of the State; to pay the interest on the State debt; to provide for the issue of the Bank of the State bonds; to effect the consolidation of the Greenville and Columbia and Blue Ridge railroads; to issue bonds for the relief of the treasury; to establish an office of land commissioner; and to define his duties; to provide for the issue of conversion bonds; to enable the financial board to effect a settlement with the financial agent.

All of these bills were enacted into laws by the legislature, and the financial board, organized system of legislative debauchery Kimpton was the chief actor and the trusted agent of Patterson, Scott, Chamberlain, and Parker, on one hand, and the financial board, on the other, and the truth of this accusation has been most fully proved before the Democratic legislative investigating committee by the testimony of Scott, Parker, Moses, Dennis, Neagle and many other members of the legislature, who have given evidence relating to Kimpton's criminal connection with the bribery of the legislature has never yet been published. It is presumed that it has been reserved for use on his trial by the investigating committee, and only one or two of the many instances where it has been plainly proved that he corrupted the legislature, or in other words, bought them up at wholesale.

Just before the session of 1870-71, when the members of the financial board and Patterson and Neagle and other leading officials, each had some pet measure of their own, and each was endeavoring to push through the legislature, it was Kimpton's business to combine the various interests and making a contract with the legislature to give them so much money to pass their various bills, the money to be paid when the bills were approved by the Governor (Scott) and before. To effect this purpose (according to the sworn testimony adduced before the investigating committee) a committee was formed, consisting of Patterson, Neagle and Kimpton, and their duties were to combine with the various members of the Senate and House and their presiding officers and ascertain how much money each would invariably demand to cast their votes in favor of every bill proposed by the legislature. Kimpton accordingly waited on Moses, who was especially instructed to Kimpton's care and supervision.
