Oakes was brought to Stillwater, where he died, and Doyle skipped out.

A man named Jeremiah Kuntz, employed by S. Anderson on the Snake river drive, was drowned last Monday. He was on a log with three other men in an eddy, not over ten feet from shore, when he fell in and went to the bottom. His remains were recovered in a couple of hours, and a big landing. He was a total stranger to his employers.
