SPORTING NEWS.

SEVERAL INTERESTING EVENTS YESTERDAY.

Hyde's Rifle Team Defeated by the English Team—Follow Expelled From the American Team—Maud S Trots at Chicago in 2:13.1—St. Louis and Minneapolis Fall Circuit—Riley Wins the Sculling Race at Bay City—Saratoga Races.

Hyde's Rifle Team Defeated. WASHINGTON, July 24.—In the American English international rifle match to-day, a 800 yards, the score stood: Americans 544, English 588.

The shooting began at 9:45 A. M., with fair light and very little wind. The teams fired in squads as follows: American team, first squad—Scott, Laird, Jackson and Rockwell. Second squad—Hyde, Gerrish, Dudley and Brown.

English team, first squad—Baker, Evans, Godsal and Humphrey. Second squad—Young, Fenton, Joynt and Milner.

The Americans commenced shooting at 9:50 o'clock, when a very light breeze sprang up. Rockwell shot the choice of a prize in the tie for the third series of extra prizes, and although Hyde offered to let him have what he wanted, he refused to shoot unless Hyde gave him a guarantee in writing that he would have the choice. The team therefore unanimously excluded him.

Grand totals—English 1,647; American 1,568. The dispute between Farrow and Hyde grew out of a tie in the third series of extra prizes. When the tie might have been shot off by Hyde's gun had broken down. The internal revenue department has made the following decisions: The special tax of \$5 to be paid by dealers in leaf tobacco, authorized by the act approved June 16, 1880, is to be reckoned like all other special taxes in the manner provided in section 3,257, United States revised statutes. If the dealer begins business after the commencement of the special tax year that tax is to be reckoned proportionally from the first day of the month in which the liability commenced to the first day of May following.

A dealer to whom the special tax stamp has been issued under the provision of said act, even though it be only for a single month—the last month of the special tax year—will be authorized to purchase or receive and to sell or consign the full amount of 25,000 pounds during that month.

Public Debt Reduction. A statement prepared at the treasury department shows the total decrease of the annual interest payable on the public debt, from August 31st, 1865, to July 1st, 1877, was \$67,817,034, and to July 1st, 1880, \$71,343,716. The public debt, less cash in the treasury, on the 31st of August, 1865, was \$2,756,431,670. Since that time the decrease has been as follows: For the ten months ending June 30, 1867, \$127,884,952. Year ending June 30, 1868, \$27,287,798. Year ending June 30, 1869, \$48,081,540. Year ending June 30, 1870, \$101,601,916. Year ending June 30, 1871, \$84,176,887. Year ending June 30, 1872, \$97,213,489. Year ending June 30, 1873, \$44,313,469. Year ending June 30, 1874, \$14,312,907. Year ending June 30, 1875, \$14,107,753. Year ending June 30, 1876, \$29,115,829. Total decrease from August 31st, 1865, to July 1st, 1876, \$625,506,290. From June 30, 1868, to March 1st, 1869, there was an increase of \$10,546,491, and from March 1st, 1869 to July 1st, 1869, there was a decrease of \$5,862,803, making the actual decrease for the year \$4,683,688. The decrease from July 1st, 1876, to January 1st, 1878, was \$52,400,189. From January 1st, 1878, to January 1st, 1879, \$14,718,839. From January 1st, 1879 to January 1st, 1880, \$69,699,767. From January 1st, 1880, to July 1st, 1880, \$67,779,803, making a total reduction of the debt from August 31st, 1865, to July 1st, 1880, \$837,104,833.

The second race was the most important of the day, and in some respects the most important of the meeting. It was for a special purse of \$1,000, between Maud S and Trimeter, \$500 to win in three straight heats. The respective horses had strong backing. When the first heat was called Maud S was only a slight favorite, at the best of it. She beat Trimeter to the turn, where both left their feet, but Maud S recovered quickly and then had the race all her own way, winning in 2:19. In the second heat Maud carried a heavy load at the start, but she made the first half in 1:07 1/2. Around the turn she slackened up, and won the heat in 2:21 1/2 easily. The third heat was surprisingly fast. Maud, as usual, set the pole at an alarming rate, that caused her companion to break and act badly, so that she was very nearly distanced. When the heat was concluded all interest in the race was in Maud S's time. She made the first quarter in 33 seconds, the half in 1:05, the three-quarter in 1:57 1/2, and the mile in 2:13 1/2. At the close she received an ovation as she clipped past the stand to her stable. The third race was for the Willoughby, Hill & Co stakes, 2:25 class, \$200 entrance, \$1,000 added. Monroe Chief was buried in the pools and in the three heats Monroe Chief was put to his speed only by Wm. H. Brans and Shorts Scarce Here—Wheat Steady but a Little Off—Provisions Fair and Advanced—The Stock Market Strong and Prices Formerly Advanced.

ST. PAUL, July 25. The only significant change of values in the local market yesterday was an advance of \$1 per ton on bran and shorts. Fruits and vegetables fluctuate from day to day, the former according to qualities of the day's offerings and the latter on account of the steadily increasing supplies.
