Alabama has fourteen iron and steel manufacturing; eighteen foundry and machine shops; 807 flouring and grist mills, and 384 lumber mills.

Bishop Logue says the people of county Donaghal have passed safely through the crisis of distress by the help of the Irish people throughout the world.

The New Hampshire legislature costs the taxpayers \$1,000 a day and the "old farmers" are unanimous in thinking the services rendered "ain't worth it."

Over 700 miles of submarine telegraph lines are completed in France, and 1,800 miles are in course of construction, to be completed by the end of this year.

Baron Nolde, a German land-owner was recently shot in Russia. His assassins are supposed to be Lithuanian peasants, who are bitter against German land-owners.

John M. Palmer of Illinois says, Tilden is his first choice for president. He says Illinois should have the next President, but should have no candidate in its own borders.

At a consistory just held at the Vatican, the Pope appointed eight Bishops for sees in Portugal, two for France, two for Mexico, one for Columbia, one for Austria, and eight for Italy.

A few mornings since the steamer William Lawrence collided with and sank the schooner Maria Lavinia in the Chesapeake Bay. The wife of the captain of the schooner and two children were drowned.

The dutch government have refused to grant the 30,000 guilders which Baron Nordenskjold claims as the discoverer of the northeast passage. The States General offered this award in 1896, but its motive was to find a passage of commercial value, while Nordenskjold had merely found a "scientific" one.

A well posted treasury official gives it as his opinion that that there is less than 15,000,000 trade dollars in the New York banks and depositories, and that before congress meets the amount will be 20,000,000. He says that the syndicate of speculators who have taken hold of the trade dollar will move on congress with a powerful lobby next winter, and that there is \$2,000,000 or \$2,500,000 in the job if they can induce the government to legitimize the coin.
