The encampment began its session at 10 o'clock today in the First Congregational church in this city. The attendance comprised about 1,000 delegates, making it one of the largest conventions ever held by the organization.

"The most disastrous results of a civil war are animosities and bitter feelings engendered thereby, and I am convinced that one of the most patriotic services we can render our country is to earnestly aid in removing every barrier that separates us or estranges the people.

Need of Woman's Corps. In his report Inspector General Wilfred A. Wetherbe of Boston, says: "I find that our weakest departments, as well as our weakest posts, are those which do not have a woman's relief corps connected with them.

Report of Adjutant General. The report of Adjutant General Silas H. Towler of Minneapolis, shows that on the 30th of June last the muster roll of the Grand Army contained 267,745 names of members in good standing and that there were 6,511 posts.
