RAILWAY STRIKE OF MAGNITUDE

Representatives of Labor Organizations With a Total Membership of 170,000 Meet in Chicago to Formulate a Demand for More Pay--A. L. U. Not Likely to Be Drawn Into It.

Chicago, Dec. 3.—The Chronicle will say today: "With the purpose of formulating requests for increases of from 10 to 20 per cent in the pay of 170,000 railroad employees committees from four powerful labor organizations are now meeting in Chicago. They are holding daily sessions in four Chicago hotels and may be expected to present their demands to railroad officials early next week. The four organizations mentioned are the Brotherhood of Locomotive Engineers, membership 41,000; Brotherhood of Locomotive Firemen, membership 47,000; Brotherhood of Railroad Trainmen, membership 60,000; Order of Railway Conductors, membership 20,000.

For the first time in eight years the four organizations are working in harmony and may be counted upon to stand together in the possibility of trouble with the railroads. It is announced that requests for increases in pay will be made by the four

organizations from every railroad system in the Middle West and Northwest. Eastern railroads entering this city will be similarly dealt with. The roads are to be given one month to meet the demands made by the organization. It is the general opinion that drastic action will be necessary. Recently in anticipation of these demands several of the railroads doing business in the Northwest have made voluntary increases in recent months in several lines of employment. Both the Northern Pacific and the Great Northern have announced slight advances to several classifications of employees.

While the probability of a strike in this part of the country on the railways is not great, such a strike is within the range of possibility. That it would not affect other lines of employment, unless carried to an extreme, is the opinion of Clarence Smith, secretary of the American Labor union, with headquarters in this city. "All the organizations mentioned in this Associated Press dispatch are independent," said Mr. Smith this morning when shown the foregoing dispatch from Chicago. "They never have affiliated with either the American Federation of Labor or the American Labor union. Neither have they had any central organization of their own.

"It is extremely unlikely that the American Labor union will be drawn into the strike, should a strike be declared." Greece Convention Concluded. Washington, Dec. 3.—United States Minister Francis has notified the state department that he has concluded a convention with Greece providing for a consular service in Greece and the United States. Siam Thanks Roosevelt. Victoria, B. C., Dec. 3.—The crown prince of Siam sent a telegram this afternoon to President Roosevelt thanking him for courtesies shown by Americans during his tour.
