Porter Grove's Dupes Reported to Be in a Starving Condition at the Camp.

Eleven Men Living in a Barn, Inadequately Clothed, and Little or no Food.

Helena People Generously Furnish a Lot of Provisions Which Will Be Taken Out to the Men To-Day.

If reports received yesterday from Hadersburg are correct, and there is no reason to doubt their truth, Chas. Porter Grove, president of the Montana & Illinois Gold Mining company, should be brought up with a sharp reprimand.

The secretary of the company, Dr. Arthur, is supposed to have made arrangements with the stores at Hadersburg to supply the men with food.

It will be remembered that Nov. 15 Grove arrived at Hadersburg with a colony of fifteen colored men from Chicago.

While the men are thus suffering in Jefferson county Grove is in Washington city, posing as a colored millionaire and philanthropist and selling stock to other colored people in the Montana and Illinois Gold Mining company at \$5 a share.
