Group of Gold Mining Claims in Jefferson County Sold to New Yorkers.

Enough Ore Is Ready to Warrant Building 300-Ton Reduction Works.

The Hope Company, of Butte, to Lease of the Boulder Smelter.

The most important mining event of the year in Montana has undoubtedly been the sale of the Golden Sunlight group of mines to an eastern company...

On the Telluride side the pay ore has been exposed 1,000 feet in length, the vein ranging from six inches to four feet in width...

These claims are located in such a manner that the principal veins can be undercut by tunnels at a depth of 500 to 700 feet below the surface...

The purchasers propose to enter actively into the further development of the mines. These operations, it is asserted, will result in the establishment of a town of at least 1,000 people before next fall.
