SIGNALING BY THE SUN.
 Remarkable Achievement of American Officers With a Small Mirror.

DENVER, Sept. 21.—Capt. W. A. Glassford, chief signal officer of the United States army for the department of Colorado, accompanied by Sergeants John McGone, James K. McLaughlin and William Bessell, arrived in Denver to-day, direct from the snow-capped heights of Mount Uncampahgre. With the assistance of Sergeants Hartach and Griffin, stationed on Mount Ellen, they succeeded in breaking the world's record for long distance heliograph signaling.

Among the congratulatory messages received by Capt. Glassford is the following, which was sent by heliograph to Mount Uncampahgre:

WASHINGTON, D. C., Sept. 18.—To Capt. W. A. Glassford, signal corps, Mount Uncampahgre, via Lake City, Col.: Congratulating you on the indefatigable exertions and skillful arrangements whereby you have broken the world's record for long distance heliograph signaling by fifty-eight miles, the United States has reason to congratulate itself upon American ingenuity, and the assiduous exertions whereby its soldiers have been enabled to transmit with a mirror of sixty-four square inches reflecting surface a message sixty-five miles further than the famous Laurel Mauritius line, between the island of Mauritius and Rivinon, with its magnificent apparatus and a mirror of 125 inches of reflecting surface. This record must stand unsurpassed for many years, if not for all time.

 NEW YORK, Sept. 21.—A movement of currency of some magnitude is in progress, the objective point being New Orleans.
