AN INDEPENDENT CANDIDATE.

Richard Lockey Wants to Go to the Legislature Again.

A formal notice was filed with the county clerk and recorder yesterday certifying to the candidacy of Richard Lockey for the legislature. The certificate is signed by the last names, which is all the law requires for independent nominations for offices which are to be filled by the electors of the county. The law requires all nominations for offices to be certified to the county clerk and recorder not later than twenty days before an election. This gives others who may contemplate running as independent candidates for office until Wednesday next to file their nominations.

Mr. Lockey was a member of the house of representatives from this county in the legislature of 1893. His name was prominently mentioned before the meeting of the last republican convention of Lewis and Clarke county. When that convention proceeded to ballot for candidates for the legislature Mr. Lockey's name was put on the blackboard along with about thirty others.
