PITTSBURG Oct. 6.—The employes of the various mills controlled by Oliver Bros. & Phillips held a meeting last night and decided unambiguously to strike against the proposed reduction of 12 1/2 per cent, which was to go into effect to-morrow.

NEW YORK, Oct. 6.—In the suit of Matthew Graham and Philip Rolly against the Atlantic Hill Gold Mining Co. brought to set aside a mortgage of \$100,000 the company made about a year ago to secure its bonds, Judge Andrews to-day decided the mortgage valid.

DENVER, Oct. 6.—The Tribune-Republican's Emporia, Kansas, special says: Early Sunday morning an attempt was made ten miles west of here to rob the Santa Fe passenger train. The robbers evidently intended to ditch the train. Two rails were unspiked, but were not removed, and when the passenger train came along it was running at such a speed that it passed safely over the rails.


