DEEPEST SNOW EVER IN THE VALLEY

THE BITTER ROOT REJOICES IN PROSPECT OF ABUNDANT WATER NEXT SUMMER.

Special to The Daily Missoulian. Hamilton, Jan. 9.—The snow in the Bitter Root valley has not been so deep in many years. It is about 22 inches on the level. People who have been living here nearly all their lives say that not in 20 years have they seen so much snow. No freight train has reached Hamilton in two days, but the passenger has made its daily visit. The snowfall was not accompanied by wind, and therefore did not drift. The rural mail carriers did not attempt to cover their entire routes yesterday, but they expect to

today. Coming at this time of the season the snow will pack in the mountains and canyons and give an abundant supply of water this summer.

The funeral of Morris Johnson, who died at Darby Wednesday morning, will be held yesterday afternoon at 4 o'clock at his late home. He was 74 years old, and was interred in the Darby cemetery. He leaves a widow and four children.
